Why should I vote in the municipal election?

WHO CAN VOTE?

To be eligible to vote you must:

- be a Canadian citizen
- be at least 18 years of age and one of the following:
- have lived in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months immediately before election day and:
 - lived in Gravelbourg for at least three consecutive months immediately before election day; or
 - be the owner of land situated in Gravelbourg for at least three consecutive months immediately before election Day

WHAT DO I NEED TO VOTE?

On election day, **you will be required to provide proof of identity to vote.** The best option is to provide government-issued photo ID that contains your name and current address.

Examples:

- valid Saskatchewan Driver's license with current address
- valid Saskatchewan ID card or non-driver's photo ID from SGI
- any other valid government-issued photo ID that contains your name and address

SGI issued photo ID takes ~10 business days to acquire. If you do not have a valid photo ID that includes your Gravelbourg address you will need to provide two other pieces of ID, both of which contain your name and at least one of which contains your address. (Example: your Saskatchewan Health Card + utility bill)

You will also need to complete a **voter registration form**. You may pick up a paper copy at the Town Office or download it from gravelbourg.ca. To save time when you go to the polling station, have your photo ID and completed voter registration ready. *The Deputy Returning Officer needs to witness your signature. Do not sign the form until you are asked to at the polling station.*
